- Depart at 7 am from Parkers Prairie, MN (please select departure on the registration)

Norsk Høstfest is held on the North Dakota State Fairgrounds in Minot. The festival provides entertainment, handcrafted Norsk merchandise, and authentic Scandinavian food.

Scandinavian tradition is on full display for the four days of the festival. From Nordic entertainment to culinary options, guests will truly have a cultural experience. Visit with artisans showcasing ancient traditions or take a walk back in time at Viking Village. No matter where you may roam during Høstfest, one thing is for sure – it will be a Nordic adventure!

About:

Norsk Høstfest - celebrates Scandinavian culture and heritage of the five Nordic countries of Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway, and Sweden. Each nation is represented in one of the halls in which the festival takes place, and each named after their country's capital city. The individual styles of each country's entertainment, food, clothes, art, and jewelry can be found throughout Norsk Høstfest.

The authentic culture that is kept alive at Norsk Høstfest. You will see everything from artisans creating handmade crafts, Scandinavian cuisine demonstrations at The Nordic Kitchen, and live Viking role-playing at Viking Village.

Million Dollar Quartet

In 1956, Carl Perkins booked a recording session on Dec. 4th with producer Sam



Phillips. Along with Jerry Lee Lewis, Perkins and his band recorded a number of songs. Perkins and Lewis were later joined by Elvis Presley and Johnny Cash, and the foursome held an impromptu jam session.

A newspaper wrote, "This quartet could sell a million." Shortly after they were known as "The Million Dollar Quartet."

Million Dollar Quartet captures the contagious spirit, freewheeling excitement, and thrilling sounds of the once-in-a-life-time event where four of music's best talents came together.

Daniel O'Donnell

Daniel O'Donnell is a fan favorite Høstfest having played at the festival many years. He was inducted into the Scandinavian-American Hall of Fame in 2018.



O'Donnell is an Irish singer that started his rise to stardom in 1983. By the mid-1990s, he had become a household name across Ireland and Great Britain. He appeared on popular television shows in both countries and won various awards. He is known for his close relationship with his fan base and his engaging stage presence. O'Donnell's music has been described as a mix of country and Irish folk and he has sold over ten million records to date.

Terry Fator

Terry Fator's journey from the plains of Corsicana, Texas to the bright lights of Las Vegas was not without its challenges. He had some help along the way, thanks to the millions of fans who named him winner of NBC's America's Got Talent.



After headlining his own record-breaking show at The Mirage Hotel & Casino for 11 years, Terry launched his new show at New York-New York

Hotel & Casino in March 2021. It features his cast of characters, including Winston the Impersonating Turtle; Maynard Tompkins, the Elvis Impersonator; Duggie Scott Walker, the annoying neighbor; and many others.

Terry is among the world's most gifted and accomplished ventriloquists, and is able to perform in more than 200 celebrity voices.

Brothers Osborne

Two sons from a working-class family, John and TJ Osborne grew up in a small Maryland water town writing and playing songs for friends and family in their father's shed. John moved to Nashville first to play in other bands and two years later, TJ joined him. It was then they formed Brothers Osborne as a duo that blends equal parts country and rock into one of the freshest, most identifiable sounds to



come out of Nashville in recent years. The singer/songwriter siblings recently took home their first trophy for Best Country Duo/Group Performance at the 64th GRAMMY Awards. Overall, Brothers Osborne have collected five CMA and six ACM trophies.

Brothers Osborne have previously toured with Chris Stapleton, Eric Church, Little Big Town, Miranda Lambert and more.
