### March 7 (Tuesday) – Twins vs Orioles

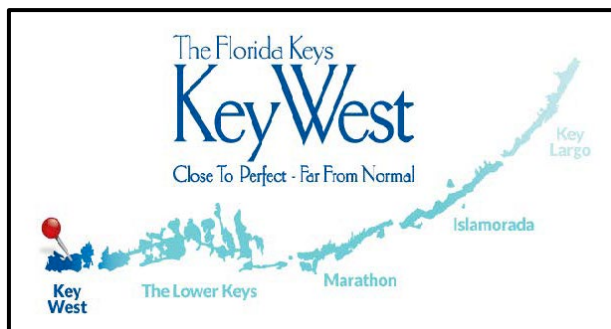

## Attractions:

- **BOK Tower Gardens:** a 250-acre contemplative garden and bird sanctuary located atop Iron Mountain, north of Lake Wales, Florida. It is home to one of 185 carillons in North America.
- **The Florida Keys:** stretch over 180 miles and have a rich history like no other place. There are actually over 800 Keys in total; a Key being a small island.
- **Overseas Highway:** often referred to as the “Highway that goes to the Sea.” This modern wonder of roadway stretches from Key Largo to Key West with scenic 110 miles of ocean views. It incorporates 42 bridges leapfrogging from Key to Key in a series of giant arches over open waters of the Atlantic Ocean, Florida Bay, and Gulf of Mexico.
- **Key West:** the final stop on the Overseas Highway; the nation’s southernmost city and it is actually closer to Havana, Cuba than Miami.
- **Dry Tortugas National Park:** located 70 miles west of Key West with the centerpiece of the island being an old, decommissioned military fort from the Civil War era.
- **Fort Jefferson:** a hexagonal fortress made of over 16 million bricks, once the largest of its kind in the US Navy. The scenic views surrounding the fort are excellent with virtually undisturbed beaches with migrating birds and marine life. The only way to get there is by ferry or sea plane.
